NONIONIZING RADIATION LICENSE

Pursuant to Chapter 4, Title 30, Arizona Revised Statutes, and Title 12, Chapter 1 of the Arizona Administrative Code, and in reliance on statements and representation made to the Agency by the licensee, a license is hereby issued authorizing the acquisition, reception, possession, use and transfer of the nonionizing sources of radiation in this license for the purposes and at the places specified. This license is subject to all applicable rules and Agency orders now or hereafter in effect and to the conditions specified.

License Conditions:

- The licensee shall notify the Arizona Radiation Regulatory Agency (ARRA) within thirty days of any change which renders the information contained in their application no longer accurate. *Changes that are not reported within thirty days or failure to pay the assessed fees shall result in termination of this license.*
- No person, in any advertisement, shall refer to the fact that a source of radiation is licensed by the ARRA and no person shall state or imply that any activity under this license has been approved by this agency.
- Authorized nonionizing radiation users for this license will be approved by the laser safety officer. A current list of the approved users will be maintained at the facility.

Pursuant to A.R.S. 30-654 and in reliance on statements and representations made by the applicant, in the application and attachments dated, March 14, 2005 the facility's non-ionizing radiation producing machines are licensed in accordance with R12-1-1304.
